

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 09-10

WHEREAS, following the ratification by Hawaii Government Employees Association (HGEA) members of a new two-year contract, on October 20, 2009, I, Linda Lingle, Governor of the State of Hawaii, announced a State furlough plan that applies to HGEA employees in the Executive Branch, State departments and their administratively attached agencies, and non-union "exempt excluded" employees in the Executive Branch;


WHEREAS, I have issued Executive Orders that ordered furloughs of certain Executive Branch employees in accordance with stated terms and conditions that will be continuing through June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, because of the ordered furloughs, unless indicated otherwise, many State offices or departments, including agencies administratively and statutorily attached to these departments, will be closed on designated furlough days.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Linda Lingle, Governor of Hawaii, pursuant to my executive authority under Article V of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and section 78-1.6 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, do hereby order that for all purposes under any statute of limitations or repose, administrative rules, and rules of practice and procedure involving executive branch administrative agencies, should a deadline or due date occur on a day for which an agency's office is closed because of furlough, such day shall be treated as a Saturday, Sunday or State holiday.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Executive Order is effective as of October 23, 2009, unless and until amended or rescinded by further Executive Order.
